

APPLICATION CRITERIA AND PROCESS



At St George Christian School music is a strong component of our curriculum and we invite gifted music students to apply for the 2023 Music Scholarship.

Applicants will ideally be proficient in at least two instruments, or an instrument and voice; however, students who have specialised in a single instrument are also invited to apply for this scholarship. As a guide, students should have reached a minimum standard of 3-4 Grade AMEB.

Students who are awarded a scholarship:

- Shall demonstrate commitment to and enthusiasm for the School's music program;
- Shall take the Music subject as an elective in Years 9-12 as one of his/her academic subjects;
- Shall be a member of the School band and/or core ensemble for his/her instrument and in the case of voice being one of the proficiencies, being a member of the school choir;
- Will have his/her scholarship reviewed annually;
- Will be expected to perform at musical recital evenings.
- Will maintain a good standard of conduct and behaviour.

The School reserves the right not to award a scholarship in any particular year.

Scholarship applicants will be required to complete an audition to be conducted at SGCS in May 2022.

Advice of the audition date and time will be forwarded subsequent to application.
