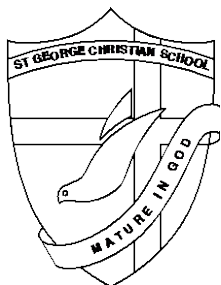
Temporary Part Time

Student Learning Support Officers (SLSO) at SGCS work collaboratively with learning support and classroom teachers, to develop strategies in Years 9-12 to support the learning of students requiring additional support across all key learning areas. All SGCS staff must meet the general school requirements of being a committed, practising evangelical Christian who is in full agreement with the school's Confession of Faith.

The successful applicant will be responsible for:

- Assisting in the supervision of education activities under the direction of the Lead Teacher Learning Support
- Supporting students requiring additional support to meet the goals within their Individual plans
- Providing in-class support to teachers and students
- Recording and monitoring information about student learning and behaviour
- Adapting occupational therapy suggestions from specialists into daily routines
- Supporting students in the acquisition of life skills: self-regulation, working with others, time management, situational behaviour, organisational/executive functioning skills
- Providing administrative support
- Providing student supervision and assisting during practical lessons (e.g. Science, Design and Technology)
- Supervising and providing disability provisions (e.g. scribing, reading) for exams
- Assisting in the coordination of teaching equipment and materials

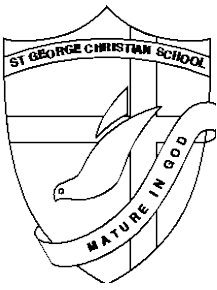
Skills and Qualifications Required:

CONFESSION OF FAITH
